DID YOU KNOW?

Arterial, Benign, Essential, Malignant, Primary and Systemic Hypertension ALL code to:
 Essential (Primary) Hypertension (I10)

To reflect higher Severity of Illness in patients with the following clinical criteria, consider:

- **Hypertensive Urgency**
 - SBP > 180 or DBP > 110 without symptoms or with headache only
- **Hypertensive Emergency**
 - SBP > 180 or DBP > 120 with chest pain or end organ damage
 - Hypertensive encephalopathy, retinal hemorrhages, papilledema, AKI
- **Hypertensive Crisis**
 - SBP > 180 or DBP > 120
 - Stroke, Heart Attack, Heart Failure, Kidney Failure
