

Documentation Using a Diagnosis-Specific Approach

Did you know?

There are no ICD-10 codes for the organ-system approach to medical record documentation

Ex: Very sick patient for which no codes can be assigned to this record as is currently documented

Assessment and Plan	Corresponding ICD-10 Code
1. ID – Continue broad spectrum ABX/fluid resuscitation. Cxs pending	none
2. Cardiovascular – BP now stable off pressors	none
3. Pulmonary – Continue vent at current settings	none
4. Renal – Creatinine now at baseline, monitor	none
5. Endocrine – BSs now controlled on home insulin	none
6. Heme – H&H stable. Iron studies pending	none

You must list specific diagnoses for which there are corresponding codes in the ICD system if you hope to receive the credit you deserve for the work you do

Ex: Very sick patient for which the severity of illness can be accurately reported

Assessment and Plan	Corresponding ICD-10 Code
1. Sepsis – Continue broad spectrum ABX/fluid resuscitation. Cxs pending	A41.9
2. Septic Shock – BP now stable off pressors	R65.21
3. Acute Hypoxic Respiratory Failure – Continue vent at current settings	J96.01
4. Acute Kidney Failure on CKD, stage 3 – Creatinine now at baseline, monitor	N17.9 & N18.3
5. DM, Type 2 with hyperglycemia – BSs now controlled on home insulin	E11.65
6. Anemia – H&H stable. Iron studies pending	D64.9
